### **DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Unload deliveries from Greater Chicago Area Food Depository Truck and other Pantry partners
- Sort and clean fresh produce
- Sort, stock, and rotate food shelves
- Date food products
- Dispose of expired food
- Reorganize food and supplies, as needed
- Prepare food bags for distribution
- Assist in the distribution of food to clients
- Assist with paperwork, as assigned

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Ability to lift boxed food items (10 50 lbs.)
- Able to work as part of a volunteer team
- Flexibility and ability to adapt to a fast-paced environment
